The program is designed to assist care givers and staff to learn to recognize the signs of a crisis development by learning the different levels of a crisis and what the response from the caregiver or staff should be. The one day program speaks about de-escalation of crisis in the hopes as to prevent a physical crisis from occurring. The program speaks about non-verbal body language as well as other external precipitating factors that can lead to communication issues and thus cause a crisis to develop.

The program will also address the area of personal safety techniques such as getting out of a hair pull or a grab. These are taught in a classroom model type of role playing.
